After praying for Rob and Kate at our AGM in February, this is an update from Charlotte Everett that appeared in the June 8th 2012 edition of the Ringing World:

Sir,

As many ringers know, Rob Austin suffered a spinal cord injury in November last year. Rob is married to Kate Everett, daughter of Charlotte who is partner to Clive Holloway. Following surgery and 4½ months in Stoke Mandeville Hospital, Rob is permanently paralysed from the chest down, and unlikely to walk again, let alone ring.

As West Oxfordshire District Council is unable/unwilling to provide a grant, we are raising money for a lift in their house to give Rob access to his bed and a bathroom! To this end we are ringing a sponsored peal at Wootton, near Woodstock, at the end of September or beginning of October. Any donations towards this would be extremely welcome.
