The second plain hunts until it is taken out of the hunt at a call. The working bells plain hunt, except when the treble moves from lead to seconds, then one bell makes thirds and the others dodge.

The order of the work is:

* 3rds * dodge 4-5 down * 4 blows in 6ths * dodge 4-5 up * 3rds

At a bob:

- the bell which would make 3rds is unaffected
- the bell which would dodge 4-5 down lies six blows in 6ths next work is 4-5
- the bell which would lie four blows in 6ths double dodges 4-5 up next work is 3rds
- the bell which would dodge 4-5 up makes 3rds and goes into the hunt
- the bell in the hunt double dodges 4-5 down and leaves the hunt next work is 4 blows in 6ths

At a single:

- the bell which would make 3rds makes 2nds and goes into the hunt
- the bell which would dodge 4-5 down lies six blows in 6ths next work is 4-5
- the bell which would lie four blows in 6ths double dodges 4-5 up next work is
- the bell which would dodge 4-5 up makes 4 blows in 3rds next work is 4-5
- the bell in the hunt double dodges 4-5 down and leaves the hunt next work is 4 blows in 6ths

By place passing treble going up
